



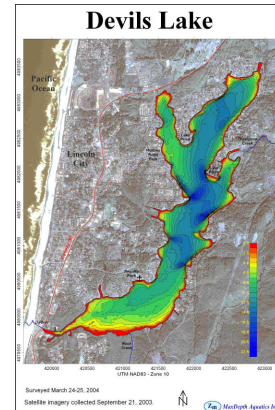

Request for Proposal: D River Emergency Dredging

Periodically the D River becomes plugged generally by sand, but also by rock and/or log debris. Clearing the channel requires removal of the sand and/or debris and placement of such material upon the shoreline immediately adjacent to the channel. This will be done in compliance with permits the District and the City of Lincoln City have obtained from Department of State Lands and Oregon Parks and Recreation. No permanent removal of sand or other materials are being requested in this solicitation.

This bid requests hourly rates and mobilization fees for excavation work during regular business hours as well as outside the regular business week including weekends and nights. Bid awardees will enter a pool of qualified contractors. Selection from the qualified contractor pool will be based on cost, availability, and performance. As storm events are unpredictable, qualified contractors will be called upon generally without notice.



The contractor must be licensed, bonded and insured for the work. The contractor must be in good standing with the city and county in regards to erosion control ordinances and with the state and federal governments in regard to wetland removal and fill and environmental compliance. The contractor must be able to provide a clean operable machine free of any hydraulic, fuel, oil, or other leaks which might cause a hazard to the environment. The contractor will be responsible for any hazardous spills as a result of doing the work. The contractor must be able to work at night with limited visibility.

This bid requires the contractor to provide the following:

- **Construction Contractors Board Number**
- **Operator(s) Name(s)**
- **Operator(s) Driver's License Number(s)**
- **Make and Color of Machine(s) to be used**
- **Body Type(s)**
- **Mobilization Fee, Excavator Drop Off and Pick Up (if applicable)**
- **Normal Hourly Rate for Excavation**
- **Weekend Hourly Rate for Excavation**
- **Nighttime Hourly Rate for Excavation**
- **Minimum hours billed (if applicable)**

Note: Bids must be valid for 18 months from November 1, 2010 through April 30th, 2012.

To be considered, the bids must be received by the District no later than 2 pm on October 29, 2010. Bids can be sent by email to lake.manager@dlwid.org or by mail to the address listed above or dropped off at the District's Office. Late bids will not be considered.
