Devils Lake Flood Protection

DLWID staff has met with Civil West Engineering in Newport regarding taking on the proposed Dredging project in the D River. Permitting costs have been determined to be between 5-12 thousand dollars to obtain the necessary permits to dredge the lake where tidal sand has historically been building up. We are still awaiting a cost estimate from a specialty contractor to perform the dredging itself.
